### 11 Constitution of Teams

(1) Each team is to be comprised of 6-8 players, plus a team manager, and a coach, for a total of 10 (Players may also act as coach and / or manager.)

A coach and a team manager may be either male or female.

Teams with less than 6 players attending at the match start time will be disqualified.

(2) A group: Teams of higher levels.

B group:: The total age of players is under 265.

C group:: The total age of players is from 266 to 287.

D group:: The total age of players is over 288.

E group: Age of all players of the team is over 50 (born before 1966).

F group: Age of all players of the team is over 60 (born before 1956).

G group: : Age of all players of the team is over 65 (born before 1951).

H group:: Age of all players of the team is over 70 (born before 1946).

The age is based on December 31, 2016

(3) Any change of players following entry should be notified to the office by

October 19 (Wed), 2016.

(4) Japanese players living in Japan must be members of Japan Ladies Badminton Federation. (B-H zone)

### 12. Method of competition:

- (1) Group Stage; Round Robin within groups (each group consits of four to five teams).
- (2) Knock Out Stage; The winning team (or the second-placed team in some cases) from each group will play on a knock out basis.
- (3) The point limit set for the matches depends on the number of participating teams.
- (4) Every player must not play in more than one doubles match for each tie.

13. Shuttles: YONEX (TOURNAMNET, NEW OFFICIAL)

14. Qualifications: Female Aged 18 and over. (born before 1998)

Players should bring a passport (copy)

15. Award: (1) A Group: Winners: JPY200,000, Runners: JPY150,000, 3rd place JPY100,000

Medals and certificates of merit are also awarded.

(2) B-H Group: Winners, Runners, and 3rd place finishers receive certificates

of merit and the extra prize.

(3) All players will receive a token of participation.
